

Cheating is defined as giving or receiving and/or using unauthorized information on a test or submitting duplicate work for individual assignments.

Plagiarism consists of representing another person's ideas or writing as one's own. Copying from a classmate, a text, or the internet is plagiarism. Plagiarism is considered cheating and the student may be subject to disciplinary action.

Consequences for cheating on a major grade assignment:

1st Offence - 1 day ISS and a grade of zero

2nd Offence - 2 days ISS and a grade of zero

(Student may follow the CHS retest policy)

3rd Offence - 3 days ISS and a grade of zero

(Student may follow the CHS retest policy)
