

Dear Parents,

We are excited to announce that Conroe High 9<sup>th</sup> Grade is one of the few campuses in the District that offer late buses for our students. Students involved in extracurricular activities, tutorials, or similar programs will have the opportunity to utilize our late buses.

The following are some important details pertaining to the late bus system. Please read over these details carefully.

1. Each late bus run will be designated by a color rather than a number.
2. Each color coded late bus will stop at the same designated stops every day scheduled for service. The only time they will not stop at the designated stop is if none of the students ride the bus that day for that stop.
3. The student is given a standardized late bus pass, daily, from their teacher in order to ride the late bus. The teacher will print this pass from our View-It student information system and it will contain all of the information the bus driver will need to drop off the student at the correct location.
4. A student will not be allowed to ride the late bus if they do not have a signed late bus pass from their teacher.
5. A student will not be dropped off at any location other than the one that has been assigned to them based on their View-it record.
6. Satellite stops are not intended to be within a short walk to each student's home, but more of a central place where parents may pick up their children without having to drive all the way to campus.
7. If you would like to view which bus your student will be riding, as well as, which designated stop they will be dropped off at, you can access this information by following these steps:

- A. Access the Conroe ISD Website by entering the website: [www.conroeisd.net](http://www.conroeisd.net)
- B. Click on **Parents/Students** located at the top of the page.
- C. Click on the **School Bus or What bus do I ride?** located on the left side of the screen.
- D. Click on the Student Eligibility tab at the bottom of the page
- E. Type in your child's Student ID and Date of Birth and click **FIND**.
- F. After you type in your child's information, it will give you the information for their Late Run Bus Stop. The time is not an exact time but an estimate of when your child will be dropped off at their designated location.
