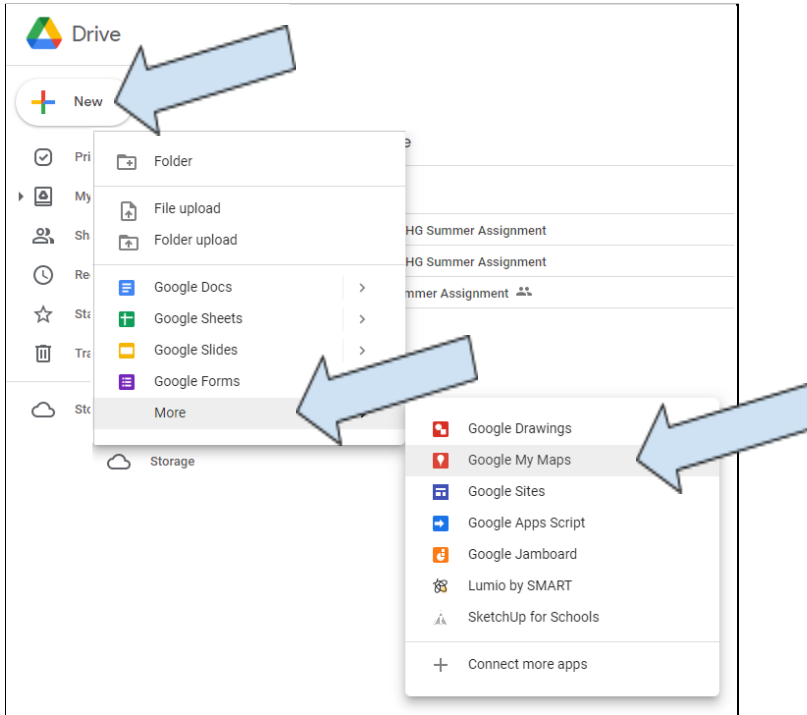
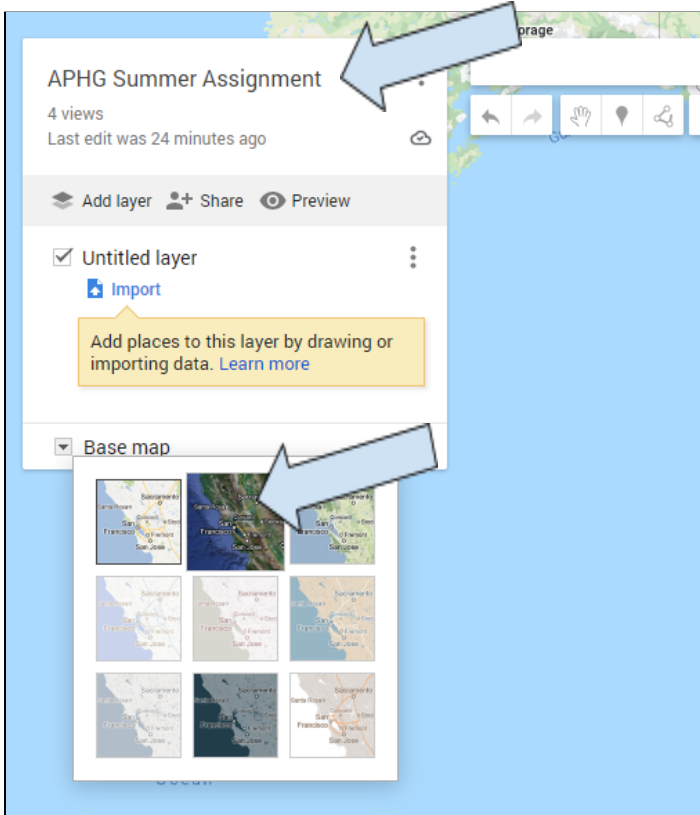


# AP Human Geography (APHG) Summer Assignment

1. Log in to Google Drive (use your student account) and click on “New”. Then go down to “More” and then click on “Google my maps”

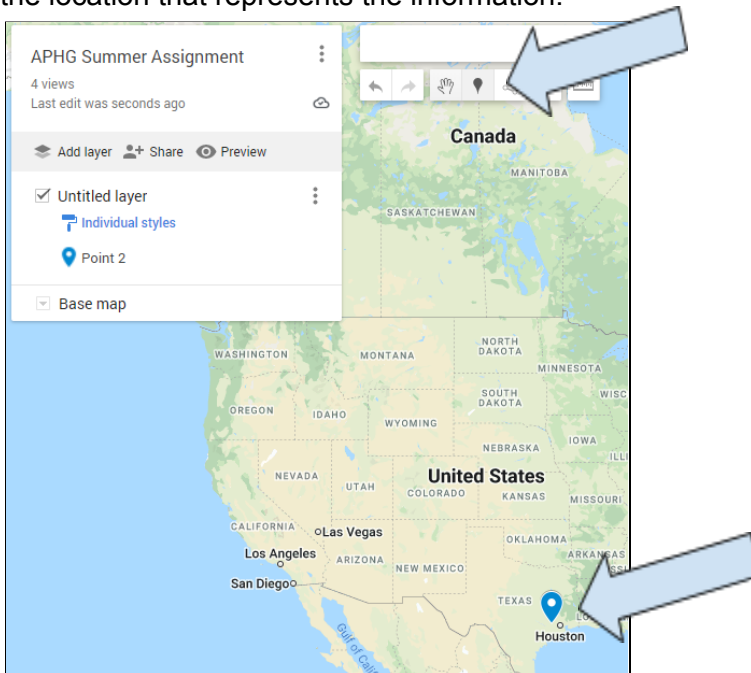


2. In your new map, change the title to “APHG Summer Assignment” and change the Base map to “Satellite”.

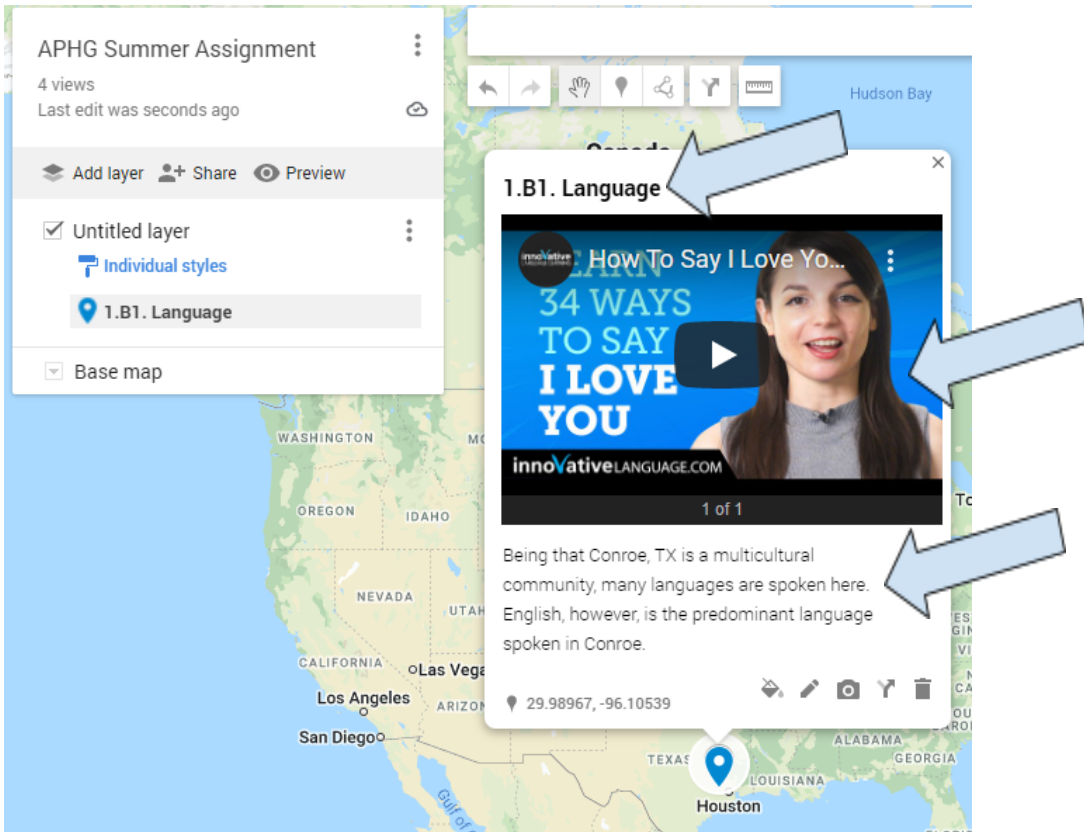
3. The map that you create will have 14 regions (listed below) with 3 locator pins (for the elements listed below) dropped within each region.
  - a. The **regions** that you will use are:
    1. US/Canada
    2. Central America
    3. Caribbean
    4. South America
    5. Western Europe
    6. Eastern Europe
    7. Siberia
    8. Middle East/North Africa/Central Asia
    9. East Asia
    10. Sub-Saharan Africa
    11. South Asia
    12. Southeast Asia
    13. Australia/Oceania
    14. Pacific Islands
  - b. The **elements** you will use are divided into 5 categories (each category has 4 elements each):
    - A. Physical
      - A1. Climate
      - A2. Major Landform
      - A3. Vegetation
      - A4. Major Natural Resource
    - B. Cultural
      - B1. Language
      - B2. Food
      - B3. Traditional Clothing
      - B4. Religion
    - C. Political
      - C1. National Border
      - C2. Stateless Nation
      - C3. Push Factor
      - C4. Pull Factor
    - D. Economic
      - D1. Primary Sector Jobs
      - D2. Secondary Sector Jobs
      - D3. Tertiary Sector Jobs
      - D4. Level of Development
    - E. Demographic
      - E1. Rapid Population Growth
      - E2. Negative/Declining Population Growth
      - E3. High Gender Inequality
      - E4. High Racial/Ethnic Diversity
4. You will use 3 elements for each region. Each element can only be used up to 3 times. For instance, let's say you decide for region 1. US/Canada you want to do element B1. Language. You would need to research some information about religion in the US and/or Canada. And now you only need to do 2 more elements for region 1, and element B1 can only be used up to 2 more times.
5. After finding the information about religions in the US/Canada, choose a location which represents the information you want to include on the map.
6. Under the Search bar at the top of the map you will see a locator pin icon. Click this and drop a pin in the location that represents the information.



7. Title the pin with the region number, element number, and element label. For instance, "1.B1. Language".

- Then click the camera icon and include pictures and/or videos that represent your information. Ensure accuracy in what you represent. (you can upload or you can do Google/YouTube searches inside of this box)
- Finally, in the text box, provide details about the item being represented. This must be written in complete sentences and must be of a depth of description befitting an AP (college-level) course. For instance, “English” or “People speak English here.” are unacceptable. (see image for an acceptable example) **BE SURE TO CLICK SAVE!**



- After pinning 2 more elements for US/Canada, change the layer title to “US/Canada”. Then click “Add Layer” and repeat steps 6 - 9 for Central America and then for each of the other regions.
